5 5 6 7	Whereas, PSC members of the City University of New York community are subjected to bullying and other forms of disrespectful and inappropriate behaviors while on CUNY campuses; and
8 9 10	Whereas, Article 1 of the UN Declaration of Human Rights declares, "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood"; and
11 12 13	Whereas, bullying is on-going and system-wide, and harmful to health and safety; and
14 15 16 17	Whereas, conditions of austerity and institutional poverty are likely to increase the incidence of workplace harassment and bullying as supervisors are put under increasing pressure to do more with less and colleagues are put in the position of competing for scarce resources; and
19 20 21	Whereas, the PSC gained agreement from CUNY management in 2019 to engage in an anti-bullying campaign; and
22 23 24 25	Whereas, in recognition of National Bullying Prevention Month in October 2020 CUNY management agreed to a joint statement with the PSC affirming a "commitment to a workplace that respects all employees, honors the dignity of all students, faculty and staff, and does not tolerate discrimination or harassment"; and
26 27 28 29 30 31	Whereas, the PSC/CUNY is an important agent in the shift towards a safe and respectful workplace that honors the dignity and values the contributions of all workers in a workplace free from harassment, retaliation, and other forms of disrespectful and harmful behavior; and
32 33 34 35	Whereas, PSC members have formed an Anti-Bullying Committee to address these issues on CUNY campuses and held several events, PSC officers and staff have convened meetings on anti-bullying throughout the year; therefore be it
36 37 38 39	Resolved, that the PSC Delegate Assembly form an ad hoc Anti-Bullying Committee for a period not to exceed one year. The committee will advise and participate in the anti-bullying campaign and consider, and recommend, and formulate policies for accountability and transparency related to workplace bullying and harassment.

PSC anti-bullying campaign affirms workers' rights to be treated with dignity and

respect in a safe and healthy work environment.
